

## **2021 Guidelines on Appeals/Reconsiderations for Admission into the University of the Philippines Manila (for those who were not offered a slot in any UP campus and those offered a slot in another UP campus)**

### *I. General*

- A. UP Manila will only entertain applicants for appeals/reconsiderations for admission whose UPG's are **2.580** (UP Manila UPG cut-off\*) or better.

\*Note: UP Manila has a different cut-off for dependents of UP employees which is 2.650

- B. Application period will be from August 5 - 9, 2021. Applications received before or after the indicated dates will not be considered.
- C. Application will only be through this link:

- D. The decisions on appeals/reconsiderations for admission are generally based on the UPG's of the applicants. However, the degree programs may have other criteria and may have screenings of applicants as indicated in item number II. The decision of the degree programs will be final and will not be appealable.
- E. The number of applicants to be accepted will depend on the number of slots that will be available, and this may vary depending on the degree program. Normally, very minimal slots open for BS courses in UP Manila.
- F. Results will be sent through the appellant's email account after the degree programs' screenings, tentatively on the last week of August.

### *II. The University of the Philippines Manila will accept Appeals/Reconsiderations for admission only for the following degree programs:*

#### **A. College of Arts and Sciences**

##### **1. BA Behavioral Sciences, BA Development Studies, BA Political Science, and BA Social Sciences (Area Studies)**

##### **2. BA Organizational Communication**

- Graduate of HUMS (HESS)/BAM/GAS strand OR If STEM strand, priority to Graduate of Science high School and laboratory high schools of State Universities including UP high schools
- English grade – 75 or higher (as computed / converted by UP Office of Admissions)

- Filipino grade – 75 or higher (as computed / converted by UP Office of Admissions)
- **Priority** will be given to those who indicated BA Organizational Communication as one of their choices of degree programs in their UPCA forms.

### 3. **BA Philippine Arts**

- **Priority** will be given to those who indicated BA Philippine Arts as one of their choices of degree programs in their UPCA forms.

### 4. **BS Applied Physics**

- Preferably from STEM track
- Grade in Math and Science equivalent to 2.0 UPG
- Interview of top applicants with live problem solving
- Priority may be given to DOST scholars

### 5. **BS Biochemistry**

- Math and Science grades equivalent to 2.0 UPG
- Interview of top applicants
- Priority may be given to DOST scholars

### 6. **BS Computer Science**

- Must be a graduate of STEM track
- Priority may be given to DOST scholars

### 7. **BS Biology**

- Minimum 85 percentile UPG score rank (as provided by the UP Office of Admissions)

## **B. College of Dentistry – Doctor of Dental Medicine**

- Converted Science grades 80 and above; (as computed / converted by UP Office of Admissions)
- Must pass an interview and dexterity examination to be administered by the College Admissions Committee

## **C. College of Pharmacy – BS Pharmacy**

- The screening procedure will include:
  - (1) First Level Screening - Pre-Interview Survey
  - (2) Second Level Screening - Interview
